Romeo, Colli Vicentini - Veneto, Italy

*Colli Vicentini is based in Montecchio Maggiore, a town near Vicenza with 2 castles said to be the inspiration behind the Montagues & Capulets.*

DOCG Valle delle Volpi, Pale Fox - Veneto, Italy

*Rated as the best Prosecco in the world by one of the top wine critics in the industry, James Suckling. Sustainable, vegan friendly and low in both sulphites & sugar, it is fermented slowly for 100 days before bottling.*

Pierre Mignon - Champagne, France

*A crisp, well-balanced champagne with citrus hints on the nose overlaid with touches of brioche and yeastiness. The palate is fresh, clean and lively with a creamy mousse and long finish.*

### **Rosé Prosecco**

Juliet - Veneto, Italy

*Delicate pink colour reminiscent of peach blossom. Fruity aromas of peach, raspberry and ripe passion fruit with a touch of flowers. It is pleasantly zesty, fresh and harmonious. The bubbles are fine and persistent.*

Valle delle Volpi, Pale Fox - Veneto, Italy

### **Pinot Grigio**

Ke Bonta - Pavia, Italy

*A crisp and delicate Pinot Grigio with gentle aromas of floral citrus and lightly honeyed notes on the palate.*

Altitudes - Valle Central, Chile

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## **Picpoul de Pinet**

Lèvre Piquante - Côteaux de Languedoc, France

*In Languedocian dialect the word Picpoul literally means "lip stinger", in reference to the wine's zippy acidity.*

*In French proper the translation would be Lèvre Piquante.*

## **Verdejo**

Viore - Rueda, Spain

*Made with the best Verdejo grapes from Bodegas Riojanas' Rueda and La Seca vineyards. It bursts with flavour, with green notes and tropical fruits coming to the fore, a blend of freshness and warmth.*

## **Sauvignon Blanc**

Stoneburn - Marlborough, New Zealand

*Made by family winery Hunter's, this is attractive and elegant on the nose, with sappy gooseberry and citrus notes and a smooth refreshing palate.*

## **Riesling Trocken (Dry)**

Solitär, S A Prüm - Mosel, Germany

*A quite simply stunning example of a dry Riesling, this is full of racy acidity and zesty freshness, with aromatic scents of apricot and peach on the nose.*

## **Mâcon Villages**

Cave de Lugny - Mâconnais, France

*The Cave de Lugny are one of largest producers in Burgundy, yet meticulously apply careful winemaking to produce a delicate and subtle wine which is not unlike Chablis in terms of body and texture, but with a more mellow, softer finish.*

Mille 951, Produttori del Gavi - Piemonte, Italy

*Harmonious and balanced, with a good weight and flavour intensity, as well as fresh acidity that sings throughout and for an impressive time after. This is what Gavi is all about.*

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## **Furmint**

Heidi Schröck & Söhne - Burgenland, Austria

*Golden yellow colour, this wine has a unique profile with aromas of golden apple and quince as well as delicate notes of chamomile and hay. The palate is beautifully textured and crisp with a well-built body and a very concentrated finish.*

## **Sancerre**

Aurore Dezat - Loire, France

*This is a family domaine that has been run by third-generation winemaker Aurore Dezat since 2011. Her Sancerre is a crisply textured wine, with attractive acidity and a strong mineral edge.*

## **Chardonnay**

Ferrum, Crystallum - Hemel en Aarde, S.Africa

*Crystallum is one of the most highly regarded wineries in South Africa and is at the forefront of the 'New Wave' movement. The Ferrum Chardonnay was aged in Austrian oak barrels (20% new), where the wine fermented naturally and remained on its lees for 10 months, gaining textural complexity.*

### **Pinot Grigio Rosé**

Ke Bonta - Pavia, Italy

*A fresh and appealing Pinot Grigio Rose with aromas of strawberry and bramble on the nose following on to a crisp and delicate palate bursting with summer fruits flavours; strawberries and cream in a glass!*

### **Zinfandel Rosé**

Sierra Creek - California, USA

*An easy drinking, medium rosé wine, full of strawberry and raspberry fruit aromas from grapes harvested in California. Light-bodied and refreshing, this wine is rich in flavours of red berry fruits.*

### **Vinho Verde Rosé**

Lago, Calçada - Vinho Verde, Portugal

Côte de Danube, Château Burgozone - Danube, Bulgaria

*A very expressive Pinot Noir Rose from Chateau Burgozone on the Danube River. Lovely character with strawberry hints and refreshing balance.*

Cuvée Classique, Ambassadeur, l'Hostellerie - Provence, France

*This blend of Grenache, Syrah and Cinsault offers nice aromas of strawberries and flowers. It is dry, delicate and subtle with fruity nuances.*

## **Rioja Tempranillo**

Antaño, Marques de Carrion - Rioja, Spain

*A really delicious glass of young Rioja. The nose shows good aromatic intensity and fruity notes, and the palate is balanced and velvety.*

## **Merlot**

Le Charme - Pays d'Oc, France

*A ruby red appearance, with lovely cassis and raspberry flavours and slightly spicy hints. A lot of fruit flavours on the palate with a hint of black pepper at the finish.*

## **Pinot Noir**

Cuvée Dissenay - Pays d'Oc, France

*Partially aged in French oak this Pinot Noir displays intense black fruit aromas followed by a hint of vanilla and cloves. On the palate the fine-grained tannins offer a velvety texture.*

## **Côtes du Rhône**

Cuvée des Galets - Rhône, France

*Vinified without sulphites at low temperature, this CDR is bottled without filtration nor fining. The resulting wine is full of fruit and sun, thanks to the warm Mediterranean weather and low yield.*

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## **Appassimento Rosso del Veneto IGP (Corvina / Merlot)**

Millefiori, Paolo Leo - Veneto, Italy

*Produced using the "appassimento" method, where the grapes are air-dried and lose up to 50% of their original weight in water, thus concentrating their colour, substance and aromas. The wine has a lovely and intense ruby-red colour with a bouquet reminiscent of cherries, dried fruit, chocolate and prunes.*

## **Gamay**

Domaine Jérémy Villemaine - Loire, France

*A superbly made Gamay from this sustainably focused producer based in the Touraine region of the Loire Valley. Light on its feet, yet displaying a surprising amount of depth it is a sure-fire winner.*

## **Mencía**

Pepe Porter - Monterrei, Spain

*Grown in a small DOC on the northern border of Portugal & Spain. This is a premium quality, versatile red made from the best bunches of grapes in the area. Goes well with everything!*

## **Malbec**

Estate, Doña Paula - Valle de Uco, Argentina

*Made from grapes sourced in the high-altitude vineyards of Gualtallary and El Cepillo, this shows great balance and freshness in the mouth, with good concentration of flavour and a medium structure.*

## **Carménère**

Armador, Odfjell - Central Valley, Chile

*Alluring purplish-red in colour with aromas of dark fruits and liquorice as well as hints of spice notes such as black pepper and cloves. The palate is long and refreshing with ripe fruit flavours and soft tannins.*

## **Petit Verdot**

Mentors, KWV - Stellenbosch, S. Africa

*This intense, ruby-red wine is concentrated and leads on the nose with cranberries, floral notes and sweet spice followed by black olives and aniseed. The palate is rich and juicy with prominent fruit sweetness. The grippy structure is well integrated and delivers an intense, lasting finish.*

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## **Médoc**

Cru Bourgeois, Château Patache d'Aux - Bordeaux, France

*Dating back to the mid-17th century, Chateau Patache d'Aux is located in the Northern Medoc, 10kms from the Gironde estuary. Produced using sustainable viticulture, this is a blend of 46% Cab Sauv, 41% Merlot, 8% Cab Franc and 2% Petit Verdot, aged for 12-14 months in a mixture of French oak and stainless steel. It is powerful, structured and long.*

## **Gigondas**

Domaine Gour de Chaule - Rhône, France

*Described as one of the most beautiful Gigondas of the vintage, this is a traditional Gigondas with perfumes and flavours of black and red fruits, herbs, black olives, coffee, pepper and warm spices. Tannins are rounded - part of the wine has been aged in oak, the rest in concrete tanks to preserve fruit flavours - and the wine quite full-bodied. It is aged about 18 months before bottling and has a long, complex finish.*

## **Beaune**

Les Epenottes, Domaine Machard de Gramont - Burgundy, France

*This wine is always good, but in this vintage the energetic winemaker, Alban, has surpassed himself. This Pinot shows a rich, brooding style, with a core of hedonistic, sweet-edged and forward black fruits, seductive texture and a nose that not only seduces but wraps you in a thickening weight of power, sweet oak, weight, boiled cherry, plum and mulling spice.*

## **Brunello di Montalcino**

Lazzeretti - Toscana, Italy

*91 points, Wine Enthusiast: 'Ripe black-skinned berry, leather and scorched earth aromas lead the nose on this structured wine. The concentrated, chewy palate offers mature black cherry, strawberry jam, star anise and black pepper alongside tightly wound tannins that need time to unwind. Drink 2022-2031.'*

### **Moscatel de Setúbal**

Alambre, JM Fonseca - Península de Setúbal, Portugal

*A fortified dessert wine with intense flavours of crystallised orange peel, honey and burnt toffee and a very long finish.*

### **LBV Port**

Pocas - Douro, Portugal

*Pocas make wines that other estates would love to make. This wine is richly decadent, full and with lovely structure. Port wine issued from a lot of high quality in a single year, matured in oak vats and bottled between the 4th and the 6th spring after the harvest.*
